- *Conclusion*

- Online remote examination is increasingly used throughout EU and worldwide
- It can support improved access to HE
- Current state of play
 - Practicality: many issues need to be solved
 - Lack of common of required procedures/rulebooks
 - Fraud detection: credibility issue?
 - Security: not bigger/smaller problem as compared other systems?
 - Privacy: an evolving domain – GDPR interpretation – relation to institutional maturity with regards to data protection
