Our goals



Can Higher Education Institutions, test providers and proctoring solution providers simply **record** and **store** a student's video and data when setting exams? Obviously not. We have explored which EU-wide regulations concerning privacy apply in online testing situations and how institutions and proctoring solution providers can comply with these regulations



How can **secure** and **reliable** exams be achieved? How does online security compare to regular campus-based examination procedures? Does online proctoring need to be much more secure and reliable than campus exams? What kinds of security risks can be identified and how can these be mitigated?



For what **types of assessments** and for which **target groups** does online proctoring provide valid and worthwhile examination opportunities. How can online proctoring support access to higher education throughout the European higher education system.
